Note:

1. General

- a Applicants are required to provide proof of previous education. Copies of notification of results, transcripts and diplomas or certificate in the application where necessary.
- b Applicants should pay a non-refundable application fee of MK10,000 for undergraduate programmes to the bank account below:
- c Details of fees payment shall be communicated in admission letters.
- d Catering services in all Campuses are outsourced. The collection and determination of catering fees is solely in the hands of the outsourced service provider. Students shall be expected to pay directly to the outsourced service provider for their food.

- e New students will arrive on 20th to 24th, May, 2024 for orientation and registration. Classes for the Semester will commence on 28th May, 2024.
- f Students for Public Health should have a registration fee of MK10, 000 for the Medical Council of Malawi paid once in the First Semester in Year 1 for the entire academic cycle.
- g **The University does not use an agent in recruitment of students and payment of fees (i.e. does not use Airtel Money, Mpamba, Mukuru, Hello Paisa and etc.).**

2. FEES STRUCTURE PER SEMESTER:

- a. Fees for bachelor's degree is as follows: Local students shall pay **MK794, 100** (residential) and **MK694, 100** (non-residential). International students shall pay US\$ **477** (residential) and **US\$ 417** (non-residential).
- b. Fees for UCE is **MK431, 250** per Semester.
- c. Fees for Diploma is **MK485.000**
- d. Fees for ODeL Theology **MK211,200**
- e. Fees for Weekend release and Evening classes is **MK618, 750**.
- f. Programmes in the Weekend and Evening are offered on non-residential basis.

3. METHOD OF PAYMENT OF FEES PER SEMESTER

- a. All applicants should provide proof of capability to pay the required fees.
- b. Upon admission into the programmes, students should pay half of the required fees per semester in order to be registered. The fees balance should be paid in at least two instalments.
- c. Students are required to **deposit fees to the bank** and produce the deposit slip during registration.
- d. The University follows a policy of **"No Fees, No admission"**.
- e. The Council of the UNILIA reserves the right to amend all fees during the course of the academic year.
