POSTGRADUATE ADMISSION - 2024 SEPTEMBER INTAKE

University of Livingstonia (UNILIA) is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates for admission to the Masters' Degree, Postgraduate Diploma and Certificate programmes for the Academic Year 2024/2025 as outlined below:

1. EKWENDENI CAMPUS

Faculty of Theology

P1. Master of Arts in Theology and Religious Studies

Description of the Programme

The Master of Theology and Religious Studies is a two (2) year course comprising 120 credits. The programme develops competence in research and allows advanced studies in a wide range of topics and disciplines in theology and religious studies. It is designed to provide graduates with a recognized qualification that enables them to participate in current theological debates relevant to Church and society and hold positions in society or in religious organizations in which academic excellence is a prerequisite. Graduates will also be equipped with knowledge and skills necessary for pursuing further studies and research at the doctoral level.

P2. Master of Arts in Theology and Gender Studies

Description of the Programme

The Master of Theology and Gender Degree focuses on deepening knowledge and skills in theology and gender. It aims to foster students' understanding of the core theological areas whilst showing how these can shape a coherent Christian approach to issues concerning gender justice and equity in Malawi and beyond.

P3. Master of Arts in Theology and Development Studies

Description of the Programme

This programme recognizes the growing need of integrating approaches to development, which in Sub-Saharan Africa have often involved the Church, with theological understanding. In so doing, it seeks to deepen students' understanding of the core theological areas while showing how these can shape a coherent Christian approach to development in Malawi and beyond. The programme will take an in-depth look at the core areas within the disciplines of theology and development studies as well as exposing students to the ways in which they can be integrated.

Mode of delivery and duration of the above programmes:

- a. The programmes will be offered through **Coursework** and **Research**, or by **Research only**.
- b. Masters by Coursework and Research will be done in **two years:** The First Year will be dedicated to coursework, and the Second Year will be dedicated to research.
- c. Masters by Research will be completed in **three years** through extensive research work and writing of modules.

Requirements for each of the three Master's Programmes:

a. Interested candidates should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Theology, or Education (Humanities), or Social and Development Studies with credit or equivalent fields from an accredited institution.

2. KANING'INA CAMPUS (located in Mzuzu City at about 0.5 km from the Mzuzu to Nkhata Bay Road at Mtwaro Flats)

Faculty of Applied Sciences

P4. Postgraduate Diploma in Global Sanitation

Description of the Programme

This is a professional diploma aimed at educating talented and ambitious young and mid-career professionals working at sewerage companies, municipal assemblies, government ministries, departments and agencies, private sector organizations, NGOs and consulting companies to deal with rural, urban and peri-urban sanitation and sanitation for vulnerable populations.

Mode of Delivery and Duration:

- a. The Postgraduate Diploma is offered through block release for a duration of 1 year (Two Semesters).
- b. The programme covers coursework only, and students will not be required to conduct research and defend the theses.

P5 Master of Science in Global Sanitation

Description of the Programme

The programme aims at educating talented and ambitious young and mid-career professionals working at sewerage companies, municipal assemblies, government ministries, departments and agencies, private sector organizations, NGOs and consulting companies to deal with rural, urban and peri-urban sanitation and sanitation for vulnerable populations. On completion of studies, the learners will become sanitation experts capable of planning, designing and implementing sanitation programmes and projects in Malawi and the world.

Mode of Delivery and Duration:

- a. This is a two-Year programme offered on full time basis through coursework and research.
- b. The first year is dedicated to coursework taught on a modular-basis through **block release**.
- c. The second year is for conducting own research and defence of the thesis.

Admission Requirements for the Post Grduate Diploma and the Master Programmes:

a. Interested candidates should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Public Health, Food Security and Nutrition, Environmental Management, Education Sciences, Community Development and other health related fields from an accredited institution. Each applicant is advised against submitting false information or forged documentation.

3. Fees structure for the programme

Fees is **MK1,100,000** per Semester for Malawian nationals and US\$1,300 per Semester for foreign students. Research fees will be determined separately.

Note:

- a. Collection and determination of catering fees is solely in the hands of outsourced service providers. Students will be expected to pay directly to the service providers for their food. Details of payments will be provided in admission letters.
- b. Details of fees payment will be communicated in the admission letters.
- c. Applicants should pay a non-refundable application fee of MK15,000 into the bank account below:

4. Method of payment of fees per Semester

a. Upon admission into the programmes, students shall pay half of the required fees per semester in order to be registered. The fees balance should be paid in at least two instalments.

- b. Students are required to deposit fees to the bank and produce the deposit slip during registration.
- c. Related costs such as meals, book allowances, field research and medical cover will be the student's responsibility.
- d. The Council of the University of Livingstonia reserves the right to amend all fees during the course of the academic year.
- e. The University does not use an agent in recruitment of its students and payment of fees.
