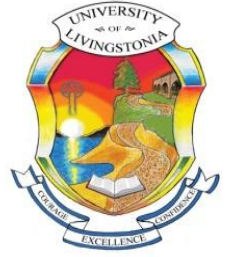

GRADUATION ARRANGEMENTS:

ACADEMIC DRESS

Distribution of academic dress shall be done on 16 October, 2024. The academic dress shall be returned on the Graduation Day by 4:00pm.

Returning the academic dress after 4:00 pm of the Graduation Day shall attract a penalty of **MK20, 000**, and thereafter an additional **MK10, 000** on each day. The penalty must be paid before collection of the certificate.

Graduands should note that:

1. Those who owe the University shall not be allowed to graduate. Fees balances should be settled by 27 September, 2024.
2. The graduation fee must be paid by 7th October, 2024.
3. Hiring of the graduation dress will be based on presenting a certified bank deposit slip.

REHEARSALS:

Rehearsals will be held on Thursday, 17 October, 2024 from 8:30 am at the Graduation Venue: Mzuzu Stadium. Graduands who will not attend rehearsals will graduate in absentia.

BACCALAUREATE SERVICE:

Baccalaureate service will be held during the Graduation Ceremony.

COLLECTION OF ACADEMIC DOCUMENTS:

Collection of certificates and transcripts will be done in person at Central Office from the graduation day onwards.

ACCREDITATION FOR PHOTOGRAPHIC AND CATERING SERVICES:

Only accredited photographers and caterers shall be allowed to operate during the graduation ceremony. Photographers must pay an accreditation fee of MK15, 000.00. The accreditation fee for caterers is MK20, 000.00. The fees must be paid to the First Capital Bank Account provided above.
