Justification

MSC Programme in Satation

The programme is hosted at Laws campus in the faculty of Applied Sciences, Department of Public Health. University of Livingstonia.

About US

The Department of Public Health was established in 2013 under the Faculty of Applied sciences. It envisions health for all a priority regardless of race, status and geographical barriers, and that disease prevention contributes to health promotion for all. The department currently offers undergraduate programme in Bachelor Science in Public Health (BSc PH) and the Master's programme in Global Sanitation will be the second programme to be offered by the department.

Entry Requirement

Students should have a credit in bachor's Degree in public Healthy, or equivalent: degree (e.g. civil, sanitation, Environmental healthy, Nursing), or a degree in other related fields (e.g. Medicine, Nursing, Community Healthy, rural and Community Development, Basic Science in Education) from recognised and accredited institutution of higher learning.

Admmission

Admission procedure includes academic acceptance;

English language proficiency check, intake assessments, application requirements met, A two way step admission process to MSc in Sanitation applies as follows:

Application meeting basic criteria with regards to academic background, and English proficiency, will receive provisional academic admission entrance.



They will be advised to study the preparatory courses in advance of the admission entrance examination and interview. Final admission will be granted after an admission interview. In this, the focus is on the prospective student's motivation and his/her mastering the basic subjects.

A failure to demonstrate the latter could result in the applicant not

being admitted. In order to qualify for final admission and a scholarship, applicants would also need to demonstrate convincingly their innovation to pursue the programme and a career in sanitation. For the programme starting this August 2021, the application deadline was 10 August 2021. For subsequent program cohorts the application is open with recruitment assessments two months prior to commencement each year.

Limited number of scholarships especially for ladies would be available. Check the program website for more information. Application deadlines for scholarships are usually much earlier than the program deadlines. first semester of each year, start by September.



Target Group

The MSc in Sanitation is dedicated to target needs and deliver specialists in a short time with the necessary qualifications. It aims to attract talented and ambitious young and mid-career sanitation professionals working in water and sewage companies, district and municipal assemblies, environmental health institutions, Government ministries, NGOs and consulting films. Ideally those individuals dealing with urban and peri-urban sanitation, especially in informal settlements. Participants should have a bachelor's degree or equivalent of engineering degrees (e.g. civil, sanitary), environmental, community development and health fields.

Programme Structure

The 240 Credit Transfer System (CTS) points programme consist of a taught and a thesis research part. The taught part is having a modular structure, comprising 13 modules ranging from 1 to 5 weeks' duration including lectures, laboratory tutorials, field trips, case studies, group work, design exercise and discussions. Students will get some lectures at Laws Campus, Kaningina Campus, Ekwendeni Campus and Smart Centre at Luwinga for lectures and laboratory sessions.
