B. POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

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1. EKWENDENI CAMPUS

Faculty of Theology

1. Master of Arts in Theology and Religious Studies
2. Master of Arts in Theology and Gender Studies

Requirements:

- a. Interested candidates should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Theology, or Education (Humanities), or Social and Development Studies with credit or equivalent fields from an accredited institution. The programmes will be offered through both **Coursework and Research**, or by **Research only**.
- b. Masters by Coursework and Research will be done in **two years**, with one year dedicated to coursework on the campus, while the second year to research.
- c. Masters by Research will be completed in **three years**, through extensive research work and writing of modules

2. KANING'INA CAMPUS

1. Master of Science in Global Sanitation

Requirements:

- a. Interested candidates should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Public Health, Food Security and Nutrition, Environmental Management, Education Sciences, Community Development and other health related fields from an accredited institution.
- b. This programme is on full time basis and by course work and research only for 2 years.

2. FEES STRUCTURE PER SEMESTER:

- a. Local students shall pay **MK585, 000** (residential) and **MK505, 000** (non-residential). International students shall pay US\$**1, 135, 00** (residential) and **US\$695** (non-residential).
- b. Fees for UCE is MK250, 000 per Semester.

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- c. Fees for Weekend release and Evening classes is **MK450, 000**. Programmes in the Weekend and Evening are offered on non-residential basis.
- d. National Postgraduate students shall pay **MK1, 500,000** per year by coursework, and **MK1, 300,000** by research (Theology only). SADC students shall pay **\$2,400** and International students will pay **\$2,600** by Course work and **US\$2,500** by research.

All applicants are required to provide proof of previous education. Copies of notification of results, transcripts and diplomas or certificates in the application where necessary.

Note:

1. Students shall be expected to pay directly to outsourced service providers for their food. The collection and determination of catering fees is solely in the hands of the outsourced service providers.
- 2. The University does not use an agent in recruitment of students and payment of fees (i.e. does not use Airtel Money, Mpamba, Mukuru, Hello Paisa and etc.).**
- 3. Students for Public Health should have a registration fee of MK10, 000 for the Medical Council of Malawi paid once in the First Semester in Year 1 for the entire academic cycle.**
4. Details of fees payment shall be communicated in admission letters.
- 5. The semester commences on 7th February, 2022.**
6. All admitted candidates shall be required to respect and **abide** by the Christian values as **practiced** by the CCAP Synod of Livingstonia.
7. Applicants should pay a non-refundable application fee of **MK10,000** for undergraduates programmes and **MK15,000** for postgraduate programmes to the bank account below:

3. **METHOD OF PAYMENT OF FEES PER SEMESTER**

- a. All applicants should provide proof of capability to pay the required fees.
- b. Upon admission into the programmes, students should pay half of the required fees per semester in order to be registered. The fees balance should be paid in at least two instalments.
- c. Students are required to **deposit fees to the bank** and produce the deposit slip during registration.
- d. The University follows a policy of "**No Fees, No admission**".
- e. The Council of the UNILIA reserves the right to amend all fees during the course of the academic year.

3. **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

- b. Attach two passport size photographs
- c. Applicants must provide proof of previous education in form of copies of notification of results or certificates.
