BRIDGING PROGRAMME

JUNE 2025 ADMISSION

University of Livingstonia (UNILIA) is inviting applications for enrolment into its Bridging Programme offered at Laws Campus. The Programme shall run from **MAY to JULY, 2025**.

Successful completion of the Bridging Programme shall lead to a candidate's enrolment into a degree programme offered by the University.

1. ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

- a. MSCE with at least four (4) credit passes; or
- b. IGSCCE or GCE 'O' level certificates with 3 credit passes; or
- c. MSCE with a minimum of three (3) credits of not more than 3 points in each plus two (2) strong passes, and with industrial experience in a relevant field; or
- d. Candidates with six credits and do not qualify for entry in some specific programmes of their choice;

2. OUTLINE OF THE BRIDGING PROGRAMME:

The choice of the courses shall be guided by the interest in pursuing a programme of one's choice. Successful applicants shall register in a combination of any four of the courses listed below:

1. Basic Communication Skills
2. Mathematics
3. Information and Communication Technology
4. Physics
5. Chemistry
6. Biology
7. History
8. Geography
9. Social and Development Studies

3. **MODE OF DELIVERY**

The Bridging Programme shall be delivered primarily on full time basis.

4. **FEES STRUCTURE AND PAYMENT**

- a. Fees for the entire 8-week duration **MK215,000.00** (residential) **MK165,000** (non-residential)
- b. Candidates are required **deposit fees to the bank** and produce the deposit slip during registration.
- c. Details of fees payment shall be communicated in admission letters.
- d. The University follows a policy of “**No Fees, No admission**”.
- e. **The University does not use an agent in recruitment of students and payment of fees (i.e. does not use Airtel Money, Mpamba, Muku, Hello Paisa, etc.).**

5. **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

- a. Application forms are accessed on the University website (www.unilia.ac.mw) and all University offices. Use an application letter where the application forms are not available.
- b. Applicants must provide proof of previous education in form of copies of notification of results or stamped letters from previous institutions or certificates.
- c. Applicants should pay a non-refundable application fee of **MK15,000.00** to the bank account below:
